The Alabama Department of Veterans' Affairs is seeking qualifications for A/E firms to provide design services, environmental assessments, historical preservation services, contract administrative services, and construction oversight for a Ten-Year Cemetery Expansion at its Alabama State Veterans Memorial Cemetery (ASVMC) at Spanish Fort, located in Baldwin County, AL. The AL-20-04 expansion phase of the ASVMC includes adding an additional 2,762 pre-placed vault gravesites for casket Interments, 800 ground plot gravesites for urn Interments, 960 Columbarium wall gravesites for urn Interments, and 100 Memorial Wall urn gravesites. Along with new roadways, irrigation, landscape development and storm drainage infrastructure to accommodate the newly expanded areas, all design aspects of the ten-year phased expansion of the ASVMC will take into consideration a State funded project to build a second Committal Shelter and Flagpole pavilion, that will be added later, and located near the new Columbarium Walls.

The Alabama Historical Commission requests qualifications statements from qualified design professionals to provide architectural and engineering services to construct a pavilion at Confederate Memorial Park located at 437 Chilton Road, Marbury, Alabama. The project involves full architectural and engineering services to construct a pavilion, similar to existing pavilions on-site, including its access sidewalk, associated utilities & septic system upgrades. The site is of historical significance and the design of the building shall reflect the period in which the site is interpreted.
