Long-awaited closure was brought to Thomas' family and community in his remains being recovered and positively identified in July 2025. Private First Class Thomas was awarded the Purple Heart, Bronze Star Medal, Prisoner of War Medal, Good Conduct Medal, Presidential Unit Citation, American Defense Service Medal, Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medal, World War II Victory Medal, Philippine Defense Ribbon, and Honorable Service Award for his bravery and sacrifice.




