PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF NEW STATE VETERANS MEMORIAL CEMETERY, MAYSVILLE, MADISON COUNTY, ALABAMA

The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and the Alabama Department of Veterans Affairs (ADVA) announce the availability of a Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) for the proposed Phase I construction and operation of a new state veterans cemetery on approximately 32 acres of undeveloped land located on the east side of County Road 69 (Maysville Road) north of the intersection with Ingram Road in Maysville, Madison County, Alabama. The Draft EA has been prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), the President's Council on Environment Quality (CEQ) regulations implementing the procedural provisions of NEPA (40 Code of Federal Regulations [CFR] 1500-1508, and VA's NEPA implementing regulations (38 CFR Part 26). VA and ADVA intend to issue a Find of No Significant Impact following a 30-day public comment period in accordance with the CEQ regulations, provided there are no substantive comments that warrant further evaluation.
